Senior Nutrition Program

To be eligible for the low-cost lunch, participants will need to fill out an application annually. A voluntary donation of \$3 is requested. Seniors under the age of 60 can purchase lunch for \$7.50. Streetlight Replacement Program

Beginning June 6th, Southern California Edison will be changing out all the streetlights to LED fixtures. The project will take 3-days and will result in better illumination at less cost due to the efficiency of the LED lighting. All 100-watt fixtures will be upgraded to 3000k warm yellow LED light with a more focused light distribution to direct the illumination downward and not outward. The efficiencies of the new lights will result in a monthly savings of approximately \$185. The Helendale CSD pays for the electricity for all the streetlights. If you are interested in seeing what these lights look like, the transition has already occurred in the cities of Barstow, Victorville and Apple Valley as well as Oro Grande. Bring your green waste to the Helendale Thrift Store

Hours: Monday – Saturday
11:00 am – 4:00 pm



Help keep our desert beautiful and dispose of your green waste the right way!

Acceptable material includes any vegetative matter resulting from normal yard and landscape maintenance. Material should not be more than 3 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter. Yard waste includes plant debris such as grass clippings, leaves, pruning, weeds, branches, brush and other forms of vegetative waste. Other restrictions may apply, see thrift store staff for complete rules.

June Watering Times: Before 9:00 am and after 6:00 pm. Due to warmer weather, it is best to water during the early morning and late evening hours to reduce evaporation.

- Take a few minutes each week to check your sprinklers for water run-off. You'll save water and save money on your water bill.
- Keep adding to mulches throughout the summer to conserve water, keep roots cool, and deter weeds. Water well before applying the mulch (or through an opening in the mulch)
