30-60% of domestic drinking water is used to water landscape.

Often a large part of a customer's water usage is from landscape irrigation. If you aren't watering efficiently, much of that water could be lost to evaporation and runoff from misdirected and broken sprinklers.

Here are a few tips to make sure you are watering efficiently:

1. Water at the right time of day – the best time to water in the summer is early in the morning before 9 am and later in the evening after 6 pm.
2. Adjust your irrigation schedule with the changing weather.
3. Check your irrigation system regularly. Make sure your sprinklers aren't leaking or misaligned.
4. Use plants that thrive in our environment. Many plants will struggle in the high temperatures we get in the summer and won't survive the cold temperatures we experience in the winter. Be sure to check the plants heat and cold tolerance as well as watering requirements.
