RESIDENTIAL FOOD WASTE DROP-OFF PROGRAM

Help reduce food waste in our community!







We are now all required to handle food waste differently. California Senate Bill 1383 mandates that we decrease the amount of food waste that goes to the landfill.

How does this affect me?

The District has been granted the opportunity to try a pilot voluntary food waste drop-off program. Residents can separate their food waste from their regular trash and dispose of it at the community drop-off location into a bin like the one in the picture above.

Are my trash rates going up?

In an effort to keep your costs down, this voluntary pilot program has been established. If the program does not produce the tonnage diversion the State is looking for then all residents will receive a third trash can at your house to put food waste in. This will increase your bill by a minimum of \$7 per month.

Do I need a bag?

Yes, you will need to put the food in a bag before you drop it in the bin. Please do not throw unbagged food in the bin.

What are the hours?

For the convenience of our residents the food waste drop off will be available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

Where do I bring my food waste?

A food waste bin will be located at the north end of the parking lot at the Community Center - 26540 Vista Rd.

CLEAN UP DAY

Mark your calendar – October 29th , 2022, from 8:00 am to 11:30 am we will be holding our annual fall clean up at the Community Center – 26540 Vista Rd. We will accept general trash, large items, electronic waste, green waste, and tires without rims (no commercial tires please). Shredding will also be available.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off:

Antifreeze, batteries, oil & filters, paint, pesticides & fertilizers, fluorescent light bulbs and tubes, home generated needles, medicine (except controlled substances).

NEW! Drop off HHW at the Community Center

Transport no more than 15 gallons or 125 lbs in containers no larger than 5 gallons. Containers must be sound and not leaking.

Senior Information

Beginning in October, Seniors 60 and older will be able to get a daily low-cost lunch at the Community Center. Lunch is served between 11:30 and 12:30. Menus will be available on the Helendale CSD website and at the Senior Center.

San Bernardino County Department of Aging and Adult Services is at the Senior Center on the third Tuesday of every month with bus passes, information on the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), FREE adult diapers and more for Seniors 60 and older.
