

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Helendale Community Services District ("HCSD") Board of Directors ("Board") will hold a public hearing on July 17, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. to consider the adoption of a Resolution to fix, adjust, levy and collect a water and a sewer standby charge in accordance with Section 61124(a) of the California Government Code ("G.C.") and the applicable provisions of the Uniform Standby Charge Procedures Act, G.C. Section 54984 et seq. ("the Act"). The meeting will be held at the HCSD board room located at 26540 Vista Rd., Suite C, Helendale, California, and online at [www.zoom.com](https://www.zoom.com) (Meeting ID: 463 173 8547 Passcode: HCSD). The Resolution is on file and available for inspection and copying during regular business hours at HCSD's office located at 26540 Vista Road, Suite B, Helendale, California.

The proposed standby charges are based on the report of a qualified engineer, Bartle Wells Associates, which is also available for inspection and copying at HCSD's office located at the above address. No change in the amount of the water and sewer standby charges, or the methodology used to calculate said charges, from the prior fiscal year is being proposed for FY 2025-26.

Before taking action on the Resolution, the Board will hear and consider all public testimony, comments, objections, and protests during the public hearing at the above date, time and location. This hearing will be conducted in the manner set forth in the Act and G.C. Section 61124(a). Any landowner desiring to protest the proposed standby charges as described in the Resolution may file a written protest with HCSD. Protests must contain a description of the land owned (this can be done by including the Assessor Parcel Number) and be signed by the owner of the property as shown on the last equalized tax roll of the County of San Bernardino. Protests may be submitted in person or mailed to the Secretary of the Board at P.O. Box 359, Helendale, California, 92342. All protests must be received by HCSD prior to the close of the public hearing on July 17, 2025. The Board may be precluded from adopting the standby charges as proposed if the number of written protests received by HCSD prior to the close of the public hearing represent the designated proportion of parcels subject to the proposed assessments as set forth under applicable law.
