Winter Watering

Avoid running sprinklers on windy days. You may think your plants have received water, but most of the moisture may have gone into the air.

Watering Schedule: Between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Consider setting irrigation timers to "off" and manually water when your plants and lawns need it. Using the manual mode on your controller in winter can save water.

Conservation Tip: Regulations adopted by the State Water Resource Control Board prohibit overwatering yards, washing cars without a shutoff nozzle, hosing down sidewalks or watering grass within 48 hours after rainfall.

Important Billing Information

Your January bill will reflect a \$5 increase in the sewer charge. This increase was approved by the Board in December 2021. Rapidly escalating costs of operating the sewer plant, collection system and completing capital projects have surpassed annual revenues. The rate increase is designed to collect sufficient revenues required to fund critical capital improvement projects, cover debt service obligations and meet increased operating expenses.
