**Fee:** \$35 per player (umpire fees included). You may join as an individual or a team. Individual players will be added to a team.


**Equipment:** Bats, personal protective equipment and uniforms to be provided by players.

Want help with cooking? The Senior Nutrition program or MEALS ON WHEELS (MOW) is a nutritional program designed



The impact of Meals on Wheels:

- 50% of seniors admitted to the hospital suffer from malnutrition severe enough to have caused their illness or to impede their recovery.
- 85% of older Americans have chronic illnesses that could be helped by better nutrition.

According to the 2011 National Survey of Older Americans Act Program participants conducted for the U.S. Administration on Aging:

- 83% of clients say MOW helps them eat healthier
- 87% say MOW helps improve their health
- 90% say MOW helps them feel more secure
- 92% say MOW means they can continue to live in their own homes
- 89% rate MOW service as good to excellent

## **Community Food Waste Drop Off**

We are now all required to handle food waste differently. California Senate Bill 1383 mandates that we decrease the amount of food waste that goes to the landfill.

**Do I need a bag?** Yes, the food must be in a bag before you drop it in the bin. Please do not throw unbagged food in the bin.

What are the hours? For the convenience of our residents, food waste drop off will be available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

Where do I bring my food waste? A food waste bin is located at the north end of the parking lot at the Community Center - 26540 Vista Rd.

Your participation helps the District meet Statemandated diversion requirements without adding a costly third barrel to your service.

Since the program began the community has recycled over 24,000 pounds of food waste! Keep up the great work. **Thank you** for helping with this program.
