Over the last few years, the CSD has been working on installing new "smart meters" throughout the community. These meters allow our Staff to monitor for potential leaks and irregular usage. If unusual usage is detected our Staff can notify customers in a timely manner. This will help customers save water!

The District has been awarded several grants from the Bureau of Reclamation and Mojave Water Agency to assist in purchasing these new meters.

Our water operations staff will continue to replace meters over the next couple of years. You may see them from time to time in your neighborhood at the meter box. The process usually takes about thirty minutes, at which time the customer's water will need to be temporarily shut off.

Please note beginning in July, the sewer service charge will increase by \$5.00 per month. Residential trash rates will increase by \$0.53 for standard service (1 trash bin and up to two recycling bins). You will see these rates reflected in your August bill.

Trash Service

The District will be transitioning from a green trash barrel to a black trash barrel. This will not affect your service in any way. Please note, you do not need to call to schedule a barrel exchange, we will exchange them automatically.

July Watering Times: Before 9:00 am and after 6:00 pm. Due to warmer weather, it is best to water during the early morning and late evening hours to reduce evaporation.

- •Check irrigation emitters, valves, sprinklers, and lines for clogs, leaks and breaks.

•Keep adding to mulches throughout the summer to conserve water, keep roots cool, and deter weeds.
