Save the Date – Fall Clean Up Day

Mark your calendar — October 28th from 8:00 am to 11:30 am we will be holding our annual fall clean up at the Community Center — 26540 Vista Rd. We will accept general trash, large items, electronic waste, green waste, and tires without rims (no commercial tires please).

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents may drop off antifreeze, batteries, oil and filters, paint, pesticides and fertilizers, fluorescent light bulbs and tubes, home generated needles, medicine (except controlled substances). Transport no more than 15 gallons or 125 lbs in containers no larger than 5 gallons. Containers must be sound and not leaking. Drop off location at the Community Center – 26540 Vista Rd. Helendale.

Recycling Services at the Thrift Store

Did you know you can drop off the following items at the Helendale Thrift Store Monday through Saturday from 11:00 am to 4:30 pm.

Mattresses - no soiled mattress or mattresses with bed bugs.

Electronics - including tv's, computers, vacuums, toasters, coffee pots, printers, etc.

Cardboard - must be broken down.

Green Waste - some exclusions apply, cannot be bagged.

Please drop off all Thrift Store donations during our regular business hours to prevent theft and keep our donation area clean. Your donations are also tax deductible, when you drop off your donations during normal business hours, please see one of our team members for your donation receipt.

The Thrift Store will also pick up your re-sellable items at no cost. To make an appointment, please call 760-952-1941.

If you have large items that are not re-sellable, you can contact the office at 760-951-0006 for a bulky item pick-up. Customers can get up to 5 items picked up twice a year.
