Helendale CSD Park Planning



Last year Helendale CSD applied for grant funding through the Statewide Parks Program to add features to the Community Park on Wild Rd. The District did get a site visit, but unfortunately, we were not awarded a grant. Round 4, the final round for this funding was recently announced and the District will once again apply for funding. Applicants can request between \$200,000 and \$8 million dollars with no matching funds required. This is an extraordinary opportunity for new park space to be created in Helendale. This round will be very competitive, as the funding opportunity is open to cities, counties, Districts, joint powers authorities and non-profits throughout the State.

Because the grant is based on points, the District has decided to focus on creating a new park at the CSD's property on Vista Rd. We are asking for the public to give their thoughts on park amenities, design, public art, safety, beautification, volunteer opportunities and more. Due to COVID-19, we have some challenges when it comes to our public meetings, since gatherings are not permitted so we have created a Facebook group called "Helendale Park Planning Group." We encourage everyone to join and give us your thoughts, ideas and feedback. We will host several webinars to have interactive discussions and presentations. Our first webinar will be held on August 11th at 3:00 pm as part of our Park and Recreation Meeting. The next webinar will be held on Saturday, August 15th at 10:00 am. These public meetings are a very important part of the public scoping process. You will be able to get the link to all our webinars on the District's website as well as our Facebook planning group.

Applications are due by December and we will find out if we are awarded the grant by next summer. If awarded our project must be completed by 2025.

Board Meetings


