

Public Safety Meeting – March 28th at 6:30 pm

In past years the community has had questions about public safety and police protection. In 2015, based upon community input the District asked the Community via a ballot question if there was interest in pursuing police protection, at that time the cost was unknown and would be paid for by



the community through an assessment. That ballot question received an overwhelmingly negative response due in part to the open-ended nature of the contract terms. The contract would be with San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department who currently provides a level of service to the community.

Recently the Sheriff's Department provided information that would appear to be more favorable in cost for a part-time deputy that would patrol the community and serve as a school resource officer for the local school district. The deputy chief in charge of contracts will be present to provide input related to how a contract would work and why they cannot guarantee a set price with a set increase as we are familiar with in the FP-5 Special Assessment for augmented fire service.

If you are interested and would like to ask questions or provide comment, you are encouraged to attend this meeting. The Helendale CSD is here to serve the needs of this community and we would like to see if there is interest in any type of contract with the Sheriff's Department.
