Helendale CSD wants to ensure that our customers have a reliable, sustainable and safe water and wastewater system and to that end we are applying for assistance from federal and state funding programs to help pay for water and wastewater system improvements and upgrades.

System improvements are costly, but with your assistance we can reduce the costs to our customers by becoming eligible for financial assistance from the State of California and the United States Government.

We need your help obtaining the financial assistance by filling out an income survey, that will be mailed to you by a third party. This income survey will be used by the funding agencies to determine the Helendale Community Services District's eligibility for low interest loans and grants. California Rural Water Association (CRWA) will perform this survey as an impartial third-party contractor. **An income survey will be mailed to you in the next few days.** Please complete the information and return it in the self-addressed and stamped envelope.

Income surveys require a high percentage of residents to respond for the survey in order for the survey to be considered valid under current guidelines. It is critical for our grant opportunities that you provide the information requested on the survey form. We cannot over-emphasize the importance of your privacy. CRWA will ensure that your responses to this survey are strictly confidential. **No personal identifying information will be reported in the survey results. The CSD will not have access to the survey data, we will only be informed of the results.**
